
Zzzooming to a new Mumbai



WHAT IT MEANS FOR CITY
The Mumbai Trans-Harbour Link (MTHL), which will be inaugurated by the prime minister today, will not only connect south Mumbai to Navi Mumbai in around 20 minutes, it will also have a long-lasting impact on the real estate and economic growth of the twin cities.

NOT JUST MTHL

Apart from MTHL, other projects that the PM will inaugurate are a twin tunnel between Borivali and Thane, the fourth railway corridor between Kharkopar and Uran, the Digha Gaon railway station, Mothagaon-Mankoli bridge, and formal launch of first line of Metro.

BUILT BEFORE TIME: MMRDAThe MTHL was scheduled to be completed by

June 2024, but the MMRDA asked the contractors to put workers in three shifts and got the bridge ready on December 25, sixth months before the deadline, MMRDA commissioner Sanjay Mukherjee told HT.
